## The Lord's Prayer

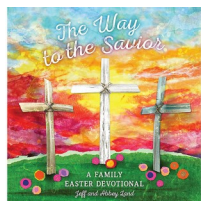
"This, then, is how you should pray:

The Lord's Prayer is a recognized passage world-wide. In some places, the Lord's Prayer is a choral reading each worship service. In both Czech Republic and Japan, I attended worship services that had several cultures represented. As we quoted/ read the Lord's Prayer, everyone was encouraged to pray this in their native language. We could have seven to ten languages being spoken at one time.

The Lord's prayer is in Matthew and in Luke. In Matthew, the disciples asked a question that Jesus is answering.

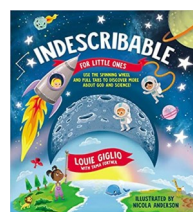
Otče náš, jenž jsi na nebesích

Jesus makes four points during this prayer: praise, making requests, asking for forgiveness, and asking for strength. PRAISE: Jesus begins the prayer acknowledging the Father and who He is. God is the Creator of all things.

MAKING REQUESTS: Jesus prayed, "Give us today our daily bread." He was praying for the needs. We are to seek God first whenever we need something.

ASK FOR FORGIVENESS: When we do wrong, when we sin, we are to ask for forgiveness.

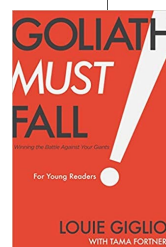

ASK FOR STRENGTH: Jesus closes the prayer with asking to "keep us from temptation." We all need to ask for this. Jesus closed the prayer with MORE PRAISE as HE says, "for Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever." I like to think of it like an oreo cookie—the cookie part being the PRAISE and the cream middle being the requests, asking for forgiveness and for strength. Because you have a cookie on either side of the cream, it's easy to remember to start with PRAISE and to end with PRAISE. Take some time in prayer. There are no right or wrong words. He wants you to spend time with Him.
