## Take TWO Class

Our Take TWO class (Sundays, 10:30 AM) is about to wrap a study on Walking Thru the Bible. As we learned the Books of the Bible, we also learned about the content within that book and the divisions (law, history, poetry, etc.)

Our next study will be The God Who Reveals Himself. We will learn five Bible Truths:

- God made our hearts to know and love Him.
- God's creation tells us about Him.
- God spoke to His people through prophets long ago.
- God speaks through His Word, the Bible.
- God reveals Himself most completely through His Son, Jesus.

For each Bible Truth, we will have an Old Testament and a New Testament example. We will also have a contemporary

example.

In Sunday school, our students are learning about the life of Jesus and how He served others. In our Take TWO class, we are taking some time each week to learn about people who serve around the church. We do not often see these people serving.

Through a short questionnaire, we have learned some fun facts—favorite sports team, favorite ice cream, favorite color, .... We have learned about their family, how they came to Christ, how and why they serve in the church, and how we can pray for them. We take the time to pray for them.

We have learned that some have served for a short time, but others have served for long periods of time (20-30+

years) in the same role. Like we learned recently, some have served 50 years. We are thankful for these examples that show us how to serve in the church. Teachers, greeters, ushers, deacons, decorators, worship team, staff, security team, committee members, VBS snack team, Ramp Gramps, baptism team, and many more areas.

As we begin our new study, the memory verses will be:

- "The Lord reveals His thoughts to man"  
Amos 4:13
- Psalm 42:1-2
- Psalm 19:1-4
- Deuteronomy 18:18-19
- Psalm 119:72-73
- Hebrews 1:1-3

We will spend three weeks on each verse.
